NO₂ Monitor at Town Hall

The Town Hall monitor records the average NO_2 concentration for each hour throughout the day as an indication of the level of air pollution. The monthly average for April was 13.5 μ g/m³, which is easily the lowest monthly value since our records began in 2013.

The monthly average chart compares the levels detected this year with the average and range of monthly figures for the years 2013 to 2019. The March and April figures show the huge benefit that Covid-19 has had on the cleanliness of our air in the centre of town. The hourly figures for all previous years have been ratified, but the figures for 2020 are provisional and have yet to be ratified.
